A FEW QUESTIONS ANSWERED . . .

What do you mean by a 'VCFS organisation'?

We have used a simple rule of thumb: an organisation which is non-statutory (not part of central government or a local authority) and non-profit making. Having said that, there is some blurring at the edges: there are some organisations here which are run by workers in the statutory services; and there are some which have paid staff or charge fees (which some people think makes them non-voluntary, but it doesn't). . .

Is every VCFS organisation in the District included?

We would like to be able to answer 'yes' to this question, but we are aware that we never track down every group and some groups do not wish to be included. If you know of an organisation which is not included, please contact us. As usual there are some new organisations, some have changed their name and sadly, we have lost some. If you can't find what you are looking for, ring us at the office on 01524 555900 x 20.

How up to date is the information?

All contact details are checked on a yearly basis. This version also incorporates recent changes up to December 2009 that we have been made aware of, and includes details of new member organisations. If you are aware that any entry is incorrect, we will be grateful if you will let us know (contact details on front cover).

What geographical area does it cover?

We have covered the local authority area - Lancaster District – which reaches from the Cumbria border in the North to Cockerham/Forton/Abbeystead in the south; from the North Yorkshire border to the sea. We have included some organisations whose area of activity is wider than this, e.g. county or region, and some organisations which work in a neighbouring District but for which there is no equivalent in Lancaster District. We haven't necessarily been consistent in this.
